

Dear parents/guardians, Dear campers and youth:

Every year we offer the opportunity to attend out Kolonie summer program at Camp Vista. Please read information below regarding Kolonie before registering.

Program: The one-week program at Camp Vista includes but is not limited to: soccer, volleyball, basketball, dodgeball, king of the jungle, lake swimming, paddle boating, kayaking, canoeing, archery, BB guns, musical activities, Bible studies, Holy Mass at some weeks, talent show, arts & crafts, campfires, help around the campground, evening gatherings, movies, and other various attractions.

Week 3: July 12-18, 2020 Ages 8-14
Week 4: July 19-25, 2020 Ages 8-14
Week 5: July 26-August 1, 2020 Ages 8-14

Age: The first two terms of Kolonie are generally for children who are between the ages of 7-12, and the next three terms are for ages 8-14. However, youth ages 14+ are welcome to participate in our Kolonie program as a junior counselor. More information about this option can be found on our website www.vistaretreat.org.

Price: Kolonie costs **\$550**. The cost for every subsequent child from the same immediate family is **\$465**. The price includes housing, meals, program participation and transportation to/from Camp Vista.

Transport: Transportation to Camp Vista will be provided by camper(s) parent/guardian. Parents should arrive at Camp Vista around 3 p.m. Due to the large costs associated with proper preparation for sanitizing the camp, there will be no discounts for providing own transportation to Camp Vista.

Registration: The application form is located on our website and should be printed, filled out, and sent to Camp Vista along with a \$50 deposit check made out to Camp Vista. Deposits need to be sent for each child for each week they are attending (i.e. two children are going for two weeks: \$50x4 = \$200 deposit). We do not accept credit cards. Checks should be written out to Camp Vista.

Timeline of Registration: We strongly encourage to not hesitate in making a reservation. We do have limited space and we have a strict rule to not accept more campers than we are prepared to supervise. [However, we will do everything in our power to have your child experience our Kolonie program.](#)

Groups at Kolonie: We organize campers according to their age group. Every group (around 10 kids) has it's own counselor. We allow children who are befriended prior to Kolonie to request being housed in the same cabin ONLY if their ages are within 2 years of each other. Please keep in mind that the older children would be placed in the younger group in this situation. There is space on the registration form to write the first and last names of other campers your child wishes to be in a group with. There are no limits on the amount of individuals that request to be in the same group. We will try to honor all possible requests, however we can only guarantee that two names will be placed together in the same group.

Resignation: You can cancel your reservation for our Kolonie summer program and receive a refund, however, the amount refunded depends on the following circumstances:

- Cancellation 30+ days before departure: amount paid minus \$50 deposit is refunded
- Cancellation 29-14 days before departure: 50% of total price is refunded
- Cancellation less than 14 days before departure: no refund will be refunded

Insurance: Insurance covering health, the case of cancellation, or any other circumstances for the duration of the Kolonie camp program can be purchased by directly contacting Travel Insured International (or any other preferred agency) at 800-243-3174 or www.travelinsured.com. The cost is usually around \$35.
