

## Camp Vista Packing List

(suggested items)

### CLOTHES

- Short sleeve t-shirts
- Long sleeve t-shirts
- Shorts
- Long pants
- Sweat pants/sweatshirt
- Pajamas and slippers
- Socks
- Undergarments
- Rain coat
- Swim suit (GIRLS: one-piece bathing suit or bring a cover up)
- Shoes (flip flops, gym shoes, etc.)
- Outfit for Thursday's dance and Friday's Talent Show (please keep in mind that this is a religious camp: dress appropriately)

### CABIN

- Towels (bathroom and beach)
- Shower supplies (shampoo, conditioner, etc.)
- Personal hygiene products (toothpaste, hairbrush, deodorant, etc.)
- Sleeping bag, pillow, bedsheet

### OTHER

- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Bug spray
- Sun glasses
- Pen, notebook, Bible
- Small backpack
- Water bottle
- Any necessary medication
- (not required) camera, flashlight, watch
- For drive to Camp Vista, we suggest packing some water and snacks
- Bag for laundry
- \$25-\$50 – money for shirts and souvenirs, canteen, crafts, and use of washer/dryer (bring \$5 in quarters and many \$1 bills)

## DO NOT BRING!!!

- Cell phones (!!!!) Dear parents, we kindly ask you to make sure your child does not have their cell phone with them. Cell phones at the camp detract from your child's summer camp experience, and make it difficult for camp leaders to manage the group. Children with cell phones often text/talk on the phone during the night, which requires the leader's constant intervention. In addition, children with phones are in constant contact with their friends from school, neighborhood, or family, and they lose interest in participating in the camp program and/or are not willing to make new friends. If your child would like to contact you, they can use our stationary office phone for free.
- Clothes promoting inappropriate images, ex. violence, alcoholic beverages, etc.
- Drinks in glass bottles, chewing gum, energy drinks
- Fireworks - ATTENTION! If your child wants to bring fireworks to camp (to use on 4<sup>th</sup> of July for example), please give the fireworks to camp organizers before the camp starts
- Audio recorder, video, radio, computer, communication devices, etc.
- Piercings: Girls may only have their ears pierced. No piercings for boys are allowed.
- Any other things that might disturb the camp program
